

**Eduarda Marques da Costa, Associate professor of the Institute of Geography and Spatial Planning of the University of Lisbon**

She was born in Lisbon in 1966, received her PhD in Spatial Planning in 2001, and is an associate professor at the Institute of Geography and Spatial Planning of the University of Lisbon.
